"stop""Rudolph with your "stop" nose so bright,

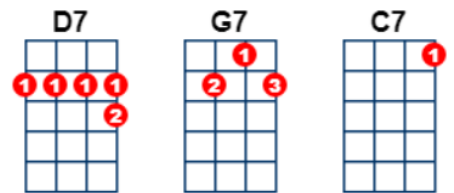

Then all the reindeer loved him, as they shouted out with glee

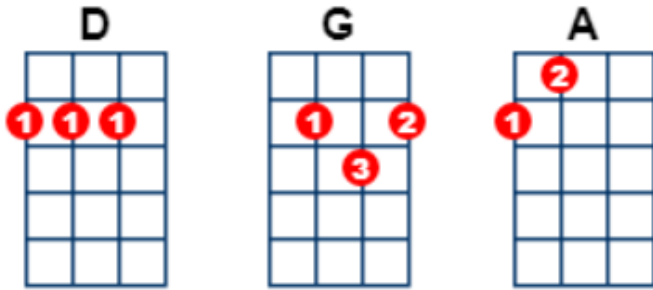
